We have developed the relationships between the schools within the Trust, supporting and enabling them to give the best for their pupils. It has been a challenging year for Daventry Hill School, but with the school's leadership team and staff and the support of the MAT senior leadership team things are moving forwards at the school and the changes are tangible.

Wren Spinney School have welcomed a new Head Teacher, Jo, who with her leadership team have introduced a new curriculum and has become a valued leader in the school.

Isebrook School has seen the opening of the Franklin Building, this beautiful new building gives more capacity and a new learning space for the older pupils in the school.

Kevin Latham is Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the Trust and Executive Head across Daventry Hill and Isebrook. Having a split role has led us as trustees to review leadership structures across all the schools, and to ensure robust and effective leadership of all the schools we are appointing Head Teachers for Daventry Hill School and Isebrook, and a Deputy Head for Wren Spinney. This will result in Kevin Latham remaining as CEO, with head Teachers in each school there will no longer be a role of Executive Head. This will ensure Kevin can concentrate on the MAT and growth of the MAT.

The Trustees and Members of the Trust, have taken time to work with the Creating Tomorrow Trust Senior Leadership Team. This includes Kevin as CEO, Esther as Chief Operating Officer (COO), Anthea as Chief Finance Officer (CFO) and the Heads of Schools. This work is ongoing, and with a strong leadership in place is enabling all the schools to develop and give great opportunities and experiences for all our pupils.
